Thus, one of the purposes of this form is to get verification from the veteran's therapist/physician that the veteran applying to Camp Resilience is capable of successfully completing the retreat. In particular, we need to ensure that participants with PTSD are in late Stage II or Stage III of recovery, i.e. their symptoms are managed by medications or self-regulation.

We would also like to verify that the veterans that have service related disabilities have priority for invitations to participate in Camp Resilience sessions. Veterans who do not have a service related disability may still participate in a Camp Resilience session if there are spaces available.
